



TR Eurotour 2014

14. September – 19. September 2014

Still not satisfied with the Dutch culture after the TR Euro weekend? The TR Eurotour 2014 is here! We invite you to drive your TR on dikes and country roads, through the picturesque villages of the Netherlands.

We will see spectacular castles, magnificent mansions, prehistoric monuments and beautiful national parks. We will visit impressive engineering feats of the steam era including an account of how the Dutch have managed to live successfully below the sea level for centuries! Comfortable hotels with dinner and breakfast are included. This itinerary is a great opportunity to get familiar with the Netherlands, a small but hospitable country.

The tour starts immediately after the TR Euromeeeting 2014. We will start from the Hague Louwman Museum and drive through the province South Holland to Hilversum, where we will have dinner and spend the first night.



The highlights for the next day are the national parks, De Veluwe and the Utrechtse heuvelrug. On way to our next destination to the hotel in Almen, we will drive by forests and castles. There will be plenty of opportunities for a relaxed walk, enjoy nature or visit one of the castles.

Our hotel in Almen is located next to Deventer, an ancient trading city. Something not to be missed, so after a well deserved breakfast, a local city tour is organized. Historical Dutch houses and cobble streets will make your day!

In the afternoon of Day 3, the trip proceeds to Westerbork in the Drenthe province. At this location, we will stay for three days to comfortably visit the 3 northern provinces of the Netherlands – Drenthe, Groningen and Friesland.



The next day starts with going back to the prehistoric era. We will visit the Borger Hunebed centre which boasts of the largest Hunebed of the Netherlands. In the afternoon, we head to Bourtange – a fortified city from 1600s, where you can stroll around and drink a beer!



The last day of the tour consists of visiting Friesland, the province where people prefer sailing over driving. We will visit the largest Steam pumping station of the world which is still in operation. This pumping station, the i.r D.F Woudagemaal has been listed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site list since 1998. The last activity of the day involves water instead of tarmac! A boat trip in the national park “De Weerribben” is planned in the afternoon.

Unfortunately, this TR Eurotour has to be concluded, but we will make sure to end it with fond memories, with dinner at the hotel and small talk at the bar. On Friday, 19th September, after breakfast, we will bid adieu and definitely look back at a fantastic week!

This 5 day trip (14-19 September) costs €695 per team of 2 persons and €535 per team of one person, including accommodation, dinner, breakfast, tourist tax and fee for the above mentioned activities wherever applicable.

Please register quickly, because the tour is limited to a maximum of 30 teams.
