Drive the Fosse Way – a ditch and road that marked the edge of the Roman Empire in 200AD



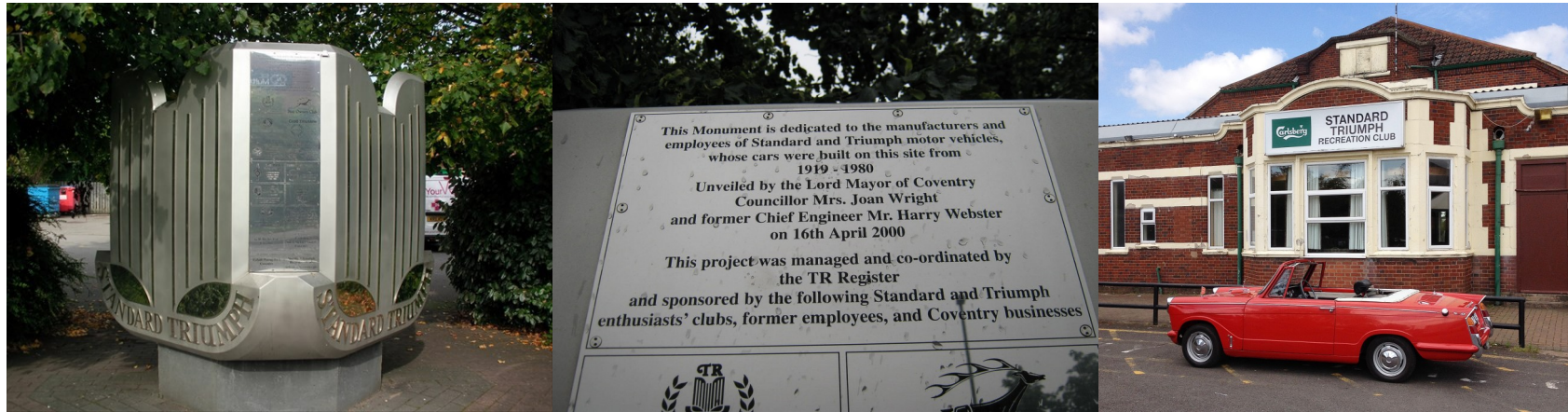
